

## RFP 2025-11 Responses: Q & A

Questions	Answers
For Indicator 17, SSIP, how many SSIP sites do you anticipate data collections occurring in or how many sites has data been collected in the past?	Currently, there are 35 sites, with the potential for the state to scale up annually.
For Indicator 8, Parent Involvement, what three languages do the surveys need to be translated into?	The Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) has a separate vendor that translates the surveys.
For Indicator 8, Parent Involvement, how many hard-copy surveys do you anticipate or have been processed in the past?	Approximately 10,000 – 15,000 surveys are received via paper survey annually.
Do you have an anticipated budget range for this work, including both Option 1 and 2?	The ALSDE is seeking competitive budgets, with a complete financial picture of the proposed project that reflects all the anticipated costs of the project. There is sufficient funding available to support both projects.
Has the Department identified a “not to exceed” amount for the first two years of the evaluation?	The ALSDE is seeking competitive budgets, with a complete financial picture of the proposed project that reflects all the anticipated costs of the project. There is sufficient funding available to support both projects.
The work would include entering “hard-copy parent-Involvement surveys into secure database. Translate comments as needed.” Does the department have an estimate of the number of expected (or past) surveys and the number that would need translation?	Approximately 10,000 – 15,000 surveys are received via paper survey annually. The number that needs translation vary according to whether or not respondents leave comments in the optional qualitative comment section.
What method is the state using for receiving, analyzing, and storing local indicator data? Is a statewide software platform used or do districts send spreadsheets to the state?	The ALSDE utilizes multiple platforms to collect APR Indicator data. For preschool data, a statewide preschool outcomes measurement tool is used. For post-school outcomes data, a statewide student information system is used. The data are sent securely to the external evaluator for data analysis. For Indicator 8 data, the data are currently being collected via paper survey or electronically via an online survey platform.
Is there an expectation for on-site technical assistance, or can all activities be virtual?	On-site and virtual technical assistance may be required depending on the ALSDE and LEA needs.

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Is there an upper limit on the amount of funding available for option 1 (indicator 7)?	The ALSDE is seeking competitive budgets, with a complete financial picture of the proposed project that reflects all the anticipated costs of the project. There is sufficient funding available to support both projects.
Where is the funding coming from to pay for this work?	These projects are being funded 100% from federal funds, <i>Individuals with Disabilities Education Act</i> (IDEA) Part B and/or IDEA Preschool funds.
Do we need to submit e-verify information for all individuals proposed, or may we submit Appendix A and provide any additional information upon contract award?	Appendix A must be submitted with proposal for the vendor submitting, any subcontractors may be provided upon request.
