

RFP 2026-04 Responses: Q & A

Questions	Answers
1. The RFP states that those eligible to apply must "[b]e licensed to practice law in the state of Alabama and be in good standing and must provide a certificate of good standing for all bars for which he/she is a member." The RFP further states in Additional factors and considerations that the "[s]upplier must provide Certificates of Good Standing for all Bars for which the Supplier is a member at the time of the submission of the proposal or a subsequent date set by the ALSDE." Does this mean that an Applicant who holds a license to practice law in another state may apply for a reciprocal license to practice law in the state of Alabama and provide a Certificate of Good Standing at "a subsequent date set by the ALSDE"?	Applicants must hold an Alabama law license or have a pending application to be considered conditionally. If conditionally considered and selected, a memorandum of agreement is dependent on admission to the Alabama State Bar.
