

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE REVIEW OF EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROGRAMS

Auburn University at Montgomery

WHEREAS, *Alabama Administrative Code* Rule No. 290-3-3-.03(6)h.(ii), requires that approval by the Alabama State Board of Education shall be secured before a proposal for new programs is reviewed by the Office of Teaching and Leading of the Alabama State Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, the State Superintendent of Education has received a written request from the President of Auburn University at Montgomery to develop new programs; and

WHEREAS, the request lists the specific proposed programs for which Alabama State Board of Education approval is sought, along with information on the factors considered in determining the need for these programs; and

WHEREAS, Auburn University at Montgomery personnel have been advised that the proposed programs may not be implemented until they receive Alabama State Board of Education approval, which is contingent upon documentation demonstrating compliance with all applicable standards and the AL-PIE new program approval process; and

WHEREAS, the State Superintendent of Education recommends that the programs be reviewed by the Office of Teaching and Leading of the Alabama State Department of Education:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Alabama State Board of Education hereby authorizes development of the following programs:

Class B General Science (6-12)
Alternative Class A Visual Impairments (P-12)
