RE: PowerSchool Student Plans and Problem-Solving Teams Processes

Problem-Solving Teams play a critical role in identifying and supporting the academic and behavioral needs of students. According to the *Alabama Administrative Code* (AAC), "Each school shall implement a Problem-Solving Team to address the needs of students who are not responding to instruction and/or behavioral interventions" (AAC 290-13-1-.02(18)). These teams use data-informed decision-making to design, implement, and monitor interventions tailored to the individualized needs of each student. The Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) has designated PowerSchool Analytics and Insights (formerly Unified Insights) as the digital platform for collecting and analyzing data for students in Grades K-12 that inform the team's decisions, improve student outcomes, and fulfill reporting requirements established within the *Alabama Literacy Act* and the *Alabama Numeracy Act*.

Beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, all student plans requiring Tier III interventions must be documented in PowerSchool Analytics and Insights:

- For students in Grades K-5 with identified consistent deficiencies in literacy, documentation must be entered using the ALSDE Student Reading Improvement Plan (SRIP). For all other identified core academic needs, including mathematics, and/or behavioral concerns, the ALSDE Problem-Solving Team (PST) Plan must be implemented.
- For students in Grades 6-12 with academic needs and/or behavioral concerns requiring Tier III interventions, documentation must be entered using the ALSDE Problem-Solving Team (PST) Plan.

Corresponding evidence-based interventions are located on the Multi-Tier System of Support (MTSS) Interventions tab within PowerSchool Analytics and Insights. For technical assistance with PowerSchool Analytics and Insights, visit <u>PowerSchool Alabama edition</u>, which includes user guides and on-demand video tutorials. In addition, <u>Virtual Office Hours</u> are held on the third Friday of every month from 10:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m. to address questions regarding Problem-Solving Teams, student plans, interventions, and PowerSchool Analytics and Insights.

To support the successful completion of End-of-Year (EOY) processes in PowerSchool Analytics and Insights, the following actions must be taken during each school's final Problem-Solving Team meeting:

- If a student's plan will be continued into the next school year, the plan's end date(s) should be extended accordingly.
- A student's ALSDE Student Reading Improvement Plan (SRIP) must be continued until the identified consistent deficiency no longer exists.
- The status of MTSS Intervention(s) must be marked **completed** by the last day of the current school year.

As part of EOY data cleanup, the following must be completed and/or verified:

- That only ALSDE-approved templates have been used for all student plans.
- That ALSDE naming conventions are applied consistently.
- That any training or test plans created during the year are deleted.
