## Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA) & State Department of Education (SDE) Driver's License Issuance

## THE STUDENT MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERION TO RECEIVE THE DRIVER'S LICENSE CERTIFICATE:

- 1. Have a valid Alabama learner's license.
- 2. Have a signed parental permission formon file in order to participate.
- 3. Successfully fulfill all the skill requirements as set forth by ALEA and SDE.
- 4. Successfully complete Driver Education.
- 5. Complete 50 hours of supervised driving with a parent or guardian.

## REMINDERS CONCERNING THE CERTIFICATES:

- 1. The certificate is <u>not valid</u> until the student turns sixteen years of age and has held a learner's license for at least six months.
- 2. Once the student turns sixteen and has held a learner's license for sixmonths and completed all required objectives, they will be eligible to obtain their driver license through an on-line process, probate or ALEA exam office.
- 3. Passing Driver Education does not guarantee that the student will receive the ALEA/SDE driver's license certificate.
- 4. Once all objectives are met, your student will be given instructions on how to obtain their Driver License.
- 5. If the student wants to obtain a first time STARID, they must visit an ALEA driver license testing office.
