The occupational proficiency assessment in effect on the date the application is received in the Educator Certification Section must be met.
- 4. The teaching experience and occupational proficiency requirements must be met prior to application submission. If these requirements are not met on the date the application is received in the Educator Certification Section of the ALSDE, the application will be closed, and the individual will be required to reapply with the submission of another application and fee. Individuals who reapply must meet the experience and occupational proficiency requirements in effect on the date the application is received in the Educator Certification.
