## ALSDE WAIVER REQUEST – EXTEND THE FIVE-YEAR ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW CYCLE FOR NSLP AND FSMC REVIEWS, CACFP ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW AND SSO MONITORING

The goal and expected outcome of this NSLP Administrative Review Waiver is to extend the five-year administrative review cycle to reduce the number of annual administrative reviews and to keep the FSMC reviews in sync with administrative reviews. This would assist ALSDE in remaining compliant with USDA administrative review requirements; increase time for technical assistance as requested by SFAs; and support SFAs during the Coronavirus Disease 2019 pandemic.

The goal and expected outcome of this CACFP Administrative Review Waiver is to reduce the burden on CNP staff and place CNP staff in a better position to operate in compliance with USDA administrative review requirements. Relief of this burden will enable staff to meet the needs of our sponsors and improve comradery and support between the State agency and sponsors during the Coronavirus Disease 2019 pandemic.

The goal and expected outcome of this SSO Monitoring Waiver is extend the SFAs monitoring deadline of February 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30, 2021. This will allow SFAs ample time to conduct monitoring based on guidance of SERO regarding monitoring requirement of SSO program.
