RE: At-Home Career and Technical Education Credentialing Options

As we continue to work through the COVID-19 pandemic together, several third-party providers from the career and technical education (CTE)-approved, industry-recognized credential list have extended learning opportunities. Across our state, many students have continued their education online and earned credentials in these extraordinary times. Approved industry-recognized credentials remain a viable part of our state's overall accountability system.

Early guidance regarding credentialing was provided in both Appendix A of the *Academic & Technical Guidance for Emergency End-of-Year School Closures Manual* (updated on April 8, 2020) and the CTE Director's Weekly Update on March 31, 2020.

Student credentialing opportunities currently extended for remote administration and proctoring appear below by Career Clusters. Local education agencies (LEAs) should refer to the <u>Career</u> <u>Readiness Indicators (CRIs) document</u> for complete details pertaining to each CRI, as those measures have not been relaxed. Details about each opportunity for remote testing can be found <u>here</u>. All remote testing for students should conclude by the last day of school.
