Recommendations for Membership on the 2020-2021 Alabama State Textbook Committee for Career and Technical Education (CTE) Clusters: Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources Grades 6-12; Law, Public Safety, Corrections, and Security Grades 6-12; and Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics

(STEM) Grades 6-12

The State Textbook Law (*Code of Alabama, 1975,* §16-36-60) provides that the Alabama State Textbook Committee be composed of four elementary teachers and four high school teachers to be appointed one from each of the seven congressional districts and one to be appointed statewide; four teachers, principals, supervisors, or superintendents to be appointed from the state-at-large; two college employees, one of whom shall be knowledgeable in the field of elementary education and one knowledgeable in the field of secondary education; and nine lay persons to be appointed by the Governor of Alabama.

Please recommend three persons who are knowledgeable in the CTE Clusters: Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources Grades 6-12; Law, Public Safety, Corrections, and Security Grades 6-12; and Science Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) Grades 6-12 from your school system to be considered for membership on the 2020-2021 Alabama State Textbook Committee for CTE Grades 6-12. Please use the attached form to recommend one elementary teacher, one high school teacher, and one member-at-large who may be a teacher, principal, or supervisor. It would be very helpful if the persons recommended are contacted to verify that they are able to serve before the names are submitted.
