SUBJECT: Modification of Required Foundational Reading Assessment as a Precondition for Initial

Certification

On March 11, 2021, members of the Alabama State Board of Education (SBOE) adopted a new foundational reading assessment as a precondition for initial certification via the Alabama-approved Educator Preparation Program Approach and other certification approaches for the areas of Elementary Education (K-6), Early Childhood Education (P-3), and Collaborative Special Education (K-6).

Foundations of Reading 190, a Massachusetts foundational reading assessment administered by the Evaluation Systems Group of Pearson, will replace Praxis #5205 Teaching Reading Elementary, the current foundational reading assessment used in Alabama.

The subsequent charts will provide additional information regarding the implementation of the Foundations of Reading 190 assessment. The Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) Assessment Policies Manual will be updated to reflect this information prior to implementation:

1. Individuals unconditionally admitted to an approved Class B or Alternative A program in Elementary Education or Early Childhood Education at an Alabama Educator Preparation Provider (EPP):

- 3. For applications through the following approaches:
 - Initial Alabama certification based upon the Certificate Reciprocity Approach (wherein content knowledge test scores are used to meet the testing requirement).
 - Certification Based on Test Approach.
 - Certificate Renewal (Reinstatement).

Testing will continue to be a requirement for certificates that have lapsed for more than 12 months and an option for certificates that have lapsed less than 12 months.
