PowerSchool SIS: Reporting Certification

Brief Description of Course:

The Reporting Certification course focuses on the many techniques you can use within PowerSchool Student Information System (SIS) to extract data and share it with others. Learn how to create reports using Object reports, ReportWorks, to build traditional and standards-based report cards, transcripts, field trip rosters and class rosters as well as learn to customize reports for your LEA.

Learn to use Enterprise Reports and Apex Builder to build data base reports that utilizes SQL query builder. Reports such as CRT/NRT test score for data analysis, attendance data, D & F reports for each school to run. Create a library of reports for Superintendents, District personnel, school personnel and allow for the end users at each school to create their own reports on discipline, grades, attendance etc.

Discuss which tool is the best option based on what data you are looking to report. A hands-on approach is used to learn the techniques of creating reports in each system.

Upon successful completion of this course work, attendees will be able to create custom reports for LEA and District needs
