

capital improvement projects estimated by a licensed design professional to cost less than \$500,000 or performing maintenance and repair to existing HVAC systems or roofs to do so without using the Division of Construction Management (DCM).

Act 2021-476 (HB 220) related to construction and renovation of school facilities goes into effect February 1, 2022. This legislation allows Local Education Agencies (LEA) performing

All projects utilizing any Public School & College Authority (PSCA) funds will still be administered by DCM's Contract Administration Division, Plan Review Division and **Project Inspection Division.**

Per the Act, all other applicable laws still apply in performing the above type projects. Furthermore, the Act stipulates that the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) shall implement necessary forms to allow the LEA to perform these projects without requiring the use of DCM. The ALSDE has constructed the required forms, utilizing DocuSign, that must be submitted prior to the project beginning. 

### Section 41-4-402

### (Effective February 1, 2022) Project design and oversight.

Nothing in Act 2021-476 shall revoke, limit, or otherwise diminish any existing state law or rule requiring that design professionals, including professional engineers, land surveyors, and architects, be used to provide project design and oversight for any project currently being reviewed and inspected by the Division of Construction Management. The project design oversight transferred to any entity pursuant to Act 2021-476 shall continue to meet all applicable state, local, and federal codes, laws, and regulations. (Act 2021-476, §7.)
