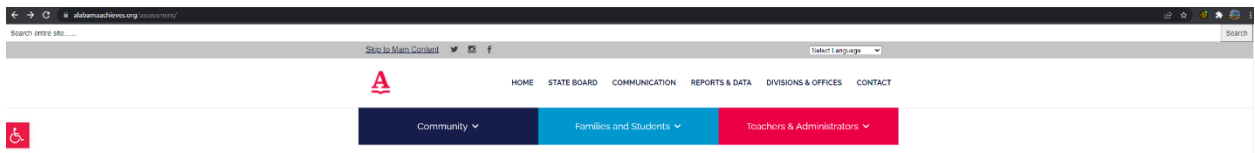


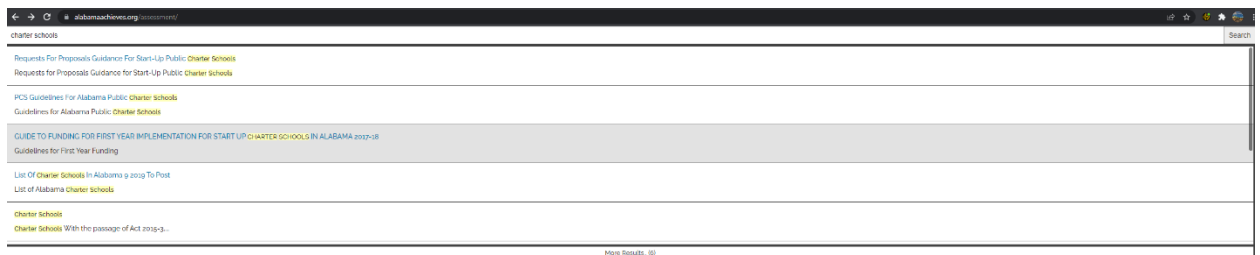
HOW TO SEARCH OUR SITE

The Alabamaachieves.org search provides multiple search methods:

1. Search the entire site. This search includes all documents and key words on the entire site.
 - a. Move your mouse to the top of the screen and click on the words “Search entire site...”



- b. Enter the text or subject you would like to search for, and press enter or select the “Search” button at the end of the search bar. Please note the search bar is interactive and will begin searching as soon as you start typing. If you enter “charter schools” in the search bar and do nothing, the results will appear beneath the search bar.



- c. Select one of the links presented and the information will be displayed.

2. Search within sections. This search limits the search scope to just documents located in this section of the website.
 - a. Select Community -> then select Charter Schools
 - b. Under the “Page Navigation” heading you will see a “Search within this section...” search box.
 - c. Move you mouse and click on the “Search within this section...” search box and enter “guidelines” and press enter or select the “Search” button at the end of the search bar. Please note this search bar is also interactive and will begin searching as soon as you start typing.

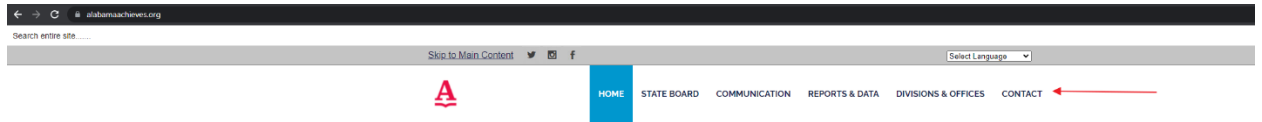
