SUBJECT: Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 State Education Trust Fund (ETF) Appropriations Grant

Awards for Special Education Services **REVISED**

For the 2021-2022 school year, local education agencies (LEAs) were afforded the opportunity to apply for additional state funding to support special education services (SES) for students with disabilities within the LEA. The ETF Appropriations Grant Program funding is made available from the ETF Appropriations Bill-Act No. 2021-342. These funds are intended to provide additional funding for the LEAs in covering the direct special education instructional costs of providing a free and appropriate public education (FAPE) to children with disabilities that would create a catastrophic financial impact on the LEA, and in providing Special Education Licensed Interpreters and Deaf/Hard of Hearing Teachers. A catastrophic need may arise when special education and related services are provided for a particular child or group of children whose needs are unduly expensive, extraordinary, and beyond the routine and reasonable special education and related services provided by the LEA.

Attached is a list of LEAs that have been awarded FY 2022 ETF Appropriations Grant Awards for special education services to date. The attached list includes awards for applications submitted through March 4, 2022. Additional state FY 2022 ETF appropriation awards may be added throughout the 2021-2022 school year as applications are submitted for any remaining funds.

Funds will be provided on a reimbursement basis upon receipt of monthly, signed, and itemized claims with supporting documentation. The final claim must be marked FINAL and received no later than October 15, 2022. The respective claim reimbursement is form attached.
