Recommendations for Membership on the 2022-2023 Alabama State Textbook Committee for Career and Technical Education (CTE) Clusters: Architecture and Construction; Information Technology; and Transportation Distribution and

Logistics

The State Textbook Law (*Code of Alabama, 1975,* §16-36-60) provides for the composition of the State Textbook Committee, which shall be composed of 23 members. The Alabama State Textbook Committee must include four elementary teachers and four secondary teachers to be appointed one from each of the eight Alabama State Board of Education districts. Four members shall be appointed from the state-at-large. These four members may be either classroom teachers or persons actively engaged in the supervisory or administrative capacity in the field of education. Two members of the committee shall be employees of state institutions of higher learning. The remaining nine members shall be appointed by the Governor of Alabama.

Please recommend three persons who are knowledgeable in the CTE Clusters: Architecture and Construction; Information Technology; and Transportation Distribution and Logistics from your school system to be considered for membership on the 2022-2023 Alabama State Textbook Committee for CTE Grades K-12. Please use the attached form to recommend one elementary teacher, one high school teacher, and one member-at-large who may be a teacher, principal, or supervisor. It would be very helpful if the persons recommended are contacted to verify that they are able to serve before the names are submitted.

Your completed form should be returned by **April 15**, **2022**, to the Alabama State Department of Education, State Textbook Program, Post Office Box 302101, Montgomery, Alabama 36130-2101. You may also send the form via email to <u>cajones@alsde.edu</u>.
