Enclosed is the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Future Teachers of Alabama (FTA) Program Director Stipend Grant application and budget. The purpose of the grant is to support FTA programs by funding stipends in the amount of \$500 for teachers to serve as FTA program directors in each Alabama senior high school with Grades 9-12.

A maximum of five hundred grants of \$500.00 each will be awarded. Funds are available for obligation from October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023. The deadline to submit this grant is Tuesday, September 6, 2022, at 4:30 p.m. Please send applications to Mrs. Kayla Cantley, Education Specialist for Career and Technical Education/Workforce Development, Alabama State Department of Education, P. O. Box 302101, Montgomery, Alabama 36130-2101.

Once the grant is approved, payment of the stipend by the local education agency to the FTA program director shall be made for \$500 less the required employer and employee match for applicable fringe benefits.
