Please duplicate as necessary or download the forms from the website. The allotment for Classroom Materials and Supplies may not be utilized to supplement common purchases,

The enclosed forms are to be used to comply with the Code of Alabama, Section 16-1-8.1, which specifies

Code of Alabama, Section 16-1-8.1, Part (13), provides that the allotment for Classroom Materials and Supplies may not be utilized to supplement common purchases when the first annual Education Budget Act after October 1, 2005, appropriates a minimum of \$200 per unit for Common Purchases. Since the FY 2008 Education Budget Act (Act 2007-361) appropriated \$200 per unit for Common Purchases, the allotment for Classroom Materials and Supplies may not be utilized to supplement common purchases. The \$900 per unit appropriated for Classroom Materials and Supplies is not subject to a vote by the budget committee.
