SUBJECT: Teacher Shortage: Expansion of Current Teacher Testing Requirement Options
On July 12, 2022, the State Board of Education temporarily approved additional teacher testing options for individuals seeking initial certification after completion of an Alabama State-Approved Educator Preparation Program or for individuals seeking to begin an alternative certification approach. These modifications are being implemented to assist local education agencies (LEAs) and educator preparation providers as they work to increase the quantity of available teachers in Alabama.

The options listed below pertain to applications received in the Educator Certification Section of the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) on July 12, 2022, and will not be available after the 2023-2024 scholastic year (June 30, 2024).

## Individuals Who Have Completed an Alabama State-Approved Educator Preparation Program:

Option 1 - Application for the Professional Educator Certificate will be made by the recommending Alabama college/university.
