Communications; Human Services; and Health Sciences) State Course of Study

Committee Nominations

In January 2023, the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) will begin working to review and revise the 2008 Revised Alabama Course of Study: Career and Technical Education. To accomplish this task, a State Course of Study Committee will be appointed.

As required by §16-35-1, *Code of Alabama*, 1975, the Alabama State Board of Education appoints 21 of the 28 members of a State Course of Study Committee, and members serve for one year. The law also states that local boards of education, through superintendents, shall nominate persons qualified to serve on a State Course of Study Committee. Your assistance is requested in the nomination of K-12 educators for consideration of appointment to this committee.

Once appointed, the committee will convene to prepare the 2023 version of the *Alabama Course of Study: Career and Technical Education*. When this work is completed, the Career and Technical Education State Course of Study Committee recommends to the Alabama State Board of Education the standards in this content area for Alabama's K-12 public schools.

Membership on the Career and Technical Education State Course of Study Committee requires a commitment to attending meetings in Montgomery and collaborating with a diverse group of educational professionals and stakeholders. The ALSDE will reimburse travel and substitute expenses for members of the Career and Technical Education Course of Study Committee.

In talking with potential appointees, it may be important to indicate the committee's meeting dates (Enclosure A) and the payment of per diem and mileage according to state rates (Enclosure B).

Nominations in the following categories are needed for this committee:

CATEGORIES FOR THE CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION COURSE OF STUDY COMMITTEE

1. <u>Elementary Classroom Teachers</u>: Persons currently teaching elementary (Grades K-6) Career and Technical Education.

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- 2. <u>Secondary Classroom Teachers</u>: Persons currently teaching secondary (Grades 7-12) Career and Technical Education.
- 3. <u>Supervisors and/or Administrators</u>: Persons having knowledge of or previous teaching experience in the field of Career and Technical Education with overall curriculum responsibility for instruction in this content area, such as elementary principals, secondary principals, supervisors, and/or assistant superintendents of instruction.
- 4. <u>Special Populations Educators</u>: Persons having knowledge of or previous teaching experience in addressing the needs of special populations.

The fillable PDF Nominations Form to be submitted from your school system may be downloaded at <u>LEA NOMINATIONS</u> Fillable Form Career and Technical Education. Once the form is completed, please upload and email it to Mrs. Cathy Jones at <u>cjones01@alsde.edu</u>. For each person nominated, the law also requires that credentials and a summary of qualifications be submitted. Please provide the nominees with the weblink to the 2023 Career and Technical Education COS Committee Credentials Form at https://forms.office.com/r/gJKUejfSyT to complete information related to their education and work history. Please ensure that all forms are completed and submitted no later than **September 12, 2022**.
