Technology Plans Not Required for 2022-2023

The Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) has a State Technology Plan that closely aligns to the National Education Technology Plan produced by the Office of Educational Technology. Two years ago, the Office of Educational Technology announced that it would be updating the national plan to reflect innovations and changes in educational technology. Work on that plan is still ongoing. Once that plan is released, the ALSDE will revise the State Technology Plan accordingly.

The ALSDE will continue to monitor the progress of the National Technology Plan and keep local education agencies (LEAs) apprised. As a result, we are **not** requiring LEAs to submit a new Technology Plan for the 2022-2023 school year.
