### Request for Proposal – Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Career and Technical Education Equipment Grant

1. Preliminary Budget/Certification Page - Each LEA must complete the preliminary budget page. The grant awards shall not exceed \$50,000.00 per grant. Grant funds will be used for new equipment, tools, trainers, related materials and supplies, and/or installation expenses that supports or facilitates student learning in a Career and Technical Education pathway. Training/professional learning on purchased equipment shall also be allowable. The funding for equipment will be used to support and enhance the building of a more qualified and skilled workforce. The proposed budget shall list the planned purchases and expected costs.

#### 2. Project Narrative:

- A. Project Overview Describe the purpose and need for the equipment, tools, trainers, and/or professional learning and how it will be used to prepare students with CTE classroom experiences that are relevant to the local, regional, or state workforce (limit to one page). (20 Points)
- B. Student Impact Describe how the equipment will impact a significant number of students in the school/center/LEA. Include the CTE program area(s) that will benefit from the equipment. (20 Points)
- C. Equity and Access Explain how the use of these grant funds will help create equity and access. (20 Points)
- D. Program Competencies Describe how the equipment aligns with program and course competencies by addressing the following design principles. (20 Points)
  - · Standards based instruction
  - Experiential and hands-on learning
  - Employer engagement
  - Instructional time utilization
  - · Student growth
- E. Workforce Relevance Provide data that supports use of the equipment for preparation and employment opportunities for in-demand occupations in the local, regional, or state workforce. (20 Points)

The estimated number of awards will be 60. The anticipated total amount to be awarded is \$3,000,000.
