To assist local education agencies in seeking Driver and Traffic Safety Education (DTSE) teachers, the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) offers the Additional Certification in Driver and Traffic Safety Education.

SUBJECT: Additional Certification and Professional Development for Driver and Traffic Safety Education

The Additional Certification in Driver and Traffic Safety Education approach is for an applicant who already holds a valid Alabama Professional Educator Certificate or Professional Leadership Certificate. The individual will need to successfully complete and earn credit for the required ALSDE basic and advanced Driver Education courses. Application forms and information pertaining to this approach can be found at https://alabamaachieves.org/teacher-center/teacher-certification/(Additional Certification in Driver and Traffic Safety Education).

Please be advised that certification through the Additional Teaching Field (CBT) and Preliminary Certificate Through Exception (ADM) approaches are no longer certification options for DTSE. The basic course will be taught November 28-December 2, 2022, and the advanced course will be taught December 5-9, 2022, at the site indicated in the first column below. Space will be limited.

The institution listed in the second column will award credits.
