RE: Principal Candidate Semester Residency – Spring 2023

The Alabama State Department of Education is committed to ensuring that every school is led by a well-prepared, resourced, supported, and effective leader. We believe that a semester residency with a veteran, successful instructional leader will help ensure that future principals are better prepared to lead the learning in Alabama's schools.

We anticipate funding from the Alabama Legislature will make it possible to fund up to eight semester residencies sponsored by local education agency (LEA)/university partnerships during the second semester of the 2022-2023 school year. The attached application for the Principal Candidate Semester Residency is for candidates seeking initial Instructional Leadership certification at an Alabama college or university. The Principal Candidate Semester Residency provides up to \$32,000 to support the salary and benefits of a certified and highly qualified teacher to replace the Residency candidate for an academic semester. This allows aspiring instructional leaders to participate in critical field-based leadership learning while providing for all the academic needs of students.

The attached application should be completed collaboratively by the sponsoring LEA/university and submitted by each candidate by November 8, 2022.
