


RE: Reminder of the Fall 20-Day Average Daily (ADM) Membership Reporting

Snapshot Approaching

As we approach the closing of the 20-Day ADM data window and the data collection deadline of the third Friday in October, I wanted to reiterate the importance of timely and accurate collection of the data contained in this file. The data elements in the 20-Day ADM report must be established before statewide funding and budgeting processes can begin.

Districts have been reminded through weekly PowerSchool update emails and at the recent curriculum and instruction meetings across the state of the importance of checking the Official State Collections tile in AIM for errors in their reporting data. Districts must ensure that all errors are resolved prior to the third Friday in October reporting date. Any student with an error in their record will not be included in the final reporting counts for the district.

Please ensure the proper staff in your district are checking the Attendance Collection Errors list in the Official State Collection tile for your district. A snapshot of this tile is shown below.

Once populated, on the right side of the page, you will see the list of errors (snapshot listed below) for your district that you will want to correct prior to the third Friday in October snapshot of data. The data will have to be corrected in PowerSchool at least 24 hours prior to the final submission deadline in order for the data to replicate up to the state AIM portal.
