WHO: CTE teachers who are seeking Master's Equivalent Technical Education 3 certification in CTE Technical Education or Health Science areas.

Enrollment Eligibility:

- Teachers who hold the Bachelor's Equivalent 2 certificate in Technical Education or Health Science area as verified with a valid teacher certificate.
- Teachers who provide verification of appropriate years of work experience (12,600 clock hours or 7 years).
- Teachers registered in PowerSchool using the PD Title or section number provided in flyer.
- Teachers who are committed to attend and participate in ALL sessions. **Failure to do so will result in removal from program.**

WHAT: The CTE TCP Level Two is a two-fold program designed to: (1) provide further professional learning and assist educational leaders in Career and Technical Education (CTE), specifically in the areas of technical education and health science, to become eligible for certification based on the Master's Equivalent 3 approach and; (2) provide local school administrators with an opportunity to recruit and retain CTE teachers based on the prospect of upward mobility within K-12 education in **Alabama**.

HOW: Through Required Coursework

Professional development supported by the Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) and ACTE Online Learning Network to ensure the use of research-based methodologies to improve instructional practices with the goal of student achievement through data-driven decision-making.

Coursework will be delivered using synchronous and asynchronous learning through a virtual platform.
