# MEMORANDUM

**RE:** Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and

Spelling (LETRS®) Stipend for Mastery

The Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) will provide a one-time stipend of \$1,000 to eligible candidates who have the LETRS® or LETRS® for Early Childhood Educators (LETRS® ECE) course and demonstrated mastery level on the Learning Platform coursework as evidenced by a score of 80% or greater on the posttest(s) for their course. The Alabama Reading Initiative (ARI) team has developed an informational flyer (attached) that can be sent to your employees to notify them of this opportunity. Each eligible candidate must submit his or her application by Friday, December 16, 2022, using the link at LETRS-Stipend for Mastery, Fall 2022 (google.com). Future stipend opportunities will be provided as long as funding is available. Notification of ongoing stipends for mastery will be sent to curriculum directors and will be announced at ARI Strong Leader, Strong Reader sessions and ARI Coaching communities. The following criteria is used to determine candidate eligibility for the current stipend opportunity.

- Completed the LETRS® (Units 1-8) or LETRS® ECE (Units 1-4) course. Course completion includes online coursework, offline coursework, bridge-to-practice activities, and face-to-face/live-virtual trainings.
- Scored at **mastery level** on the Learning Platform coursework as evidenced by a score of 80% or greater on the **posttest(s)** for the course.
  - o LETRS® Units 1-4 Posttest and Units 5-8 Posttest
  - o LETRS® ECE: Units 1-4 Posttest
  - o For applicants needing a retest, complete the <u>Test Retake Form</u>. The deadline to submit the Test Retake Form is Friday, December 9, 2022.
- Properly certified by the State of Alabama. This includes emergency certified teachers.
- Employed (full-time, part-time, or contracted) educators of an Alabama public PreK-12 school or Institutions of Higher Education (IHEs) including, but not limited to, PreK-12 teachers, building administrators, central office administrators or support, professors, assistant professors, paraprofessionals, instructional assistants, local reading specialists, and regional literacy specialists. Only PreK teachers who are **not** eligible for the Alabama Department of Early Childhood Educators (DECE) stipend will be eligible for the one-time stipend provided by the ALSDE.

No stipend is available for the LETRS® for Administrators' Course, as there is no pre-/post-assessment. However, administrators who have achieved mastery status in LETRS® or LETRS® ECE are eligible for the stipend.

Although educators will receive a \$1,000 stipend, the local education agency (LEA) or IHEs will receive \$1,200 from the ALSDE. The extra \$200 will cover the employer benefit costs associated with the stipend. Please be aware that the stipend is considered income and, subsequently, is taxed as income. This \$1,000 stipend is not guaranteed from year-to-year and is being provided based on the state's *Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief II* (ESSER II) federal appropriation for this current FY 2023. These funds are reimbursable to the district. Districts must use the **LEA Code 4303-ESSER II LETRS** when requesting these funds. Upon completion of candidate notification and verification, the LEA will request reimbursement for all eligible candidates. Any remaining portion of the allocation after the stipend and benefit expenses are paid, should be used for high-quality instructional materials for that teacher's classroom. **Please be aware that there is an extensive application verification in addition to the time needed to process funds at the ALSDE and LEA levels.**

## **WHAT**

- Scored at mastery level on the Learning Platform coursework as evidenced by a score of 80% or greater on the posttest(s) for the course.
  - LETRS® Units 1-4 Posttest AND LETRS® Units 5-8 Posttest
  - LETRS® ECE: Units 1-4 Posttest

\*For applicants needing a retest, complete the <u>Test Retake Form</u>. The deadline to complete the Test Retake Form will be Friday, December 9, 2022.
