Secretary and Executive Officer The State Textbook Law (*Code of Alabama, 1975*, §16-36-60) provides for the composition of the State Textbook Committee, which shall be composed of 23 members. The Alabama State Textbook Committee must include four elementary teachers and four secondary teachers to be appointed one from each of the eight Alabama State Board of Education districts. Four members shall be appointed from the state-at-large. These four members may be either classroom teachers or persons actively engaged in the supervisory or administrative capacity in the field of education. Two members of the committee shall be employees of state institutions of higher learning. The remaining nine members shall be appointed by the Governor of Alabama.
