REVIEW OF THE DRAFT 2023 ALABAMA COURSE OF STUDY: CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND THE 2023 ALABAMA COURSE OF STUDY: SCIENCE – CALL FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Montgomery, AL – In a constant effort to improve outcomes for students, the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) is asking for public feedback specifically related to the *Draft 2023 Alabama Course of Study: Career and Technical Education* and the *Draft 2023 Alabama Course of Study: Science*.

This review is an opportunity to offer feedback related to each standard for each course. These drafts contain the proposed Grades 6-12 Career and Technical Education content for Arts A/V Technology and Communication, Health Science, and Human Services and Grades K-12 science content. Standards in these documents specify what students in Alabama should know and be able to do.

In order to receive public input, the survey and a copy of the draft are being made available on the ALSDE website and will be posted from Monday, July 31, 2023, through 5:00 p.m. Friday, September 1, 2023.
