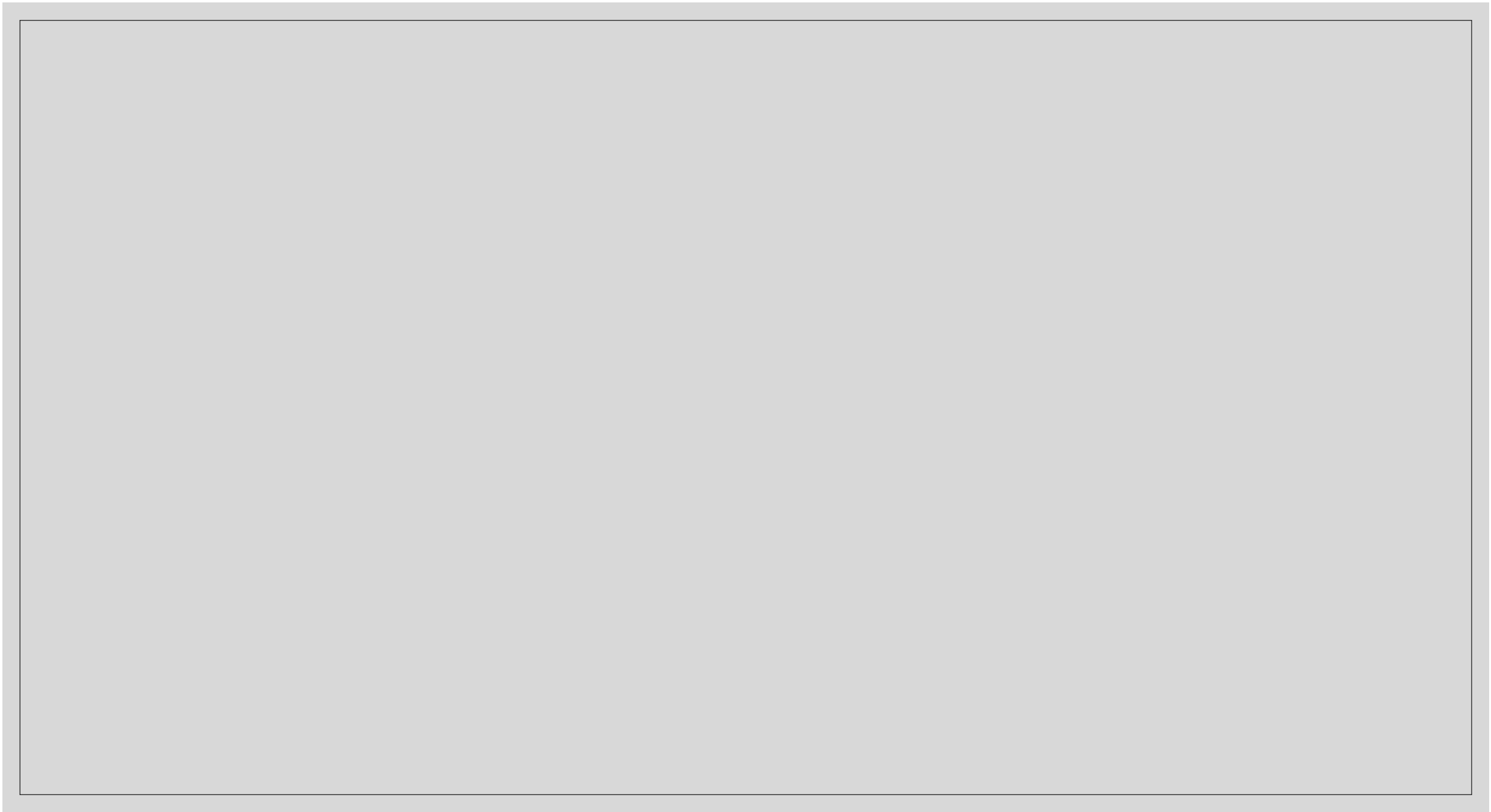

- **A good procurement consists of four principles:**
  - **Free and open competition;**
  - **Fairness and integrity;**
  - **Responsive and responsible contractors, and;**
  - **Transparency.**



# Procurement Process

**Going through the procurement process is to ensure that the LEA receives goods and services:**

- **from the most responsible vendor;**
- **from the most responsive bid;**
- **at the lowest possible price.**

# Procurement Thresholds:

- **1. Micro-Purchase: < \$10,000**
- **2. Small Purchase/Informal: <\$15,000**
- **3. Formal Purchase: >\$15,000**
  
- **Unprocessed Agricultural Products: < \$150,000**
