Priority Schools as Defined by the Alabama Act 2023-418

(Act 2023-418, p.5)

Priority Schools are public K-12 schools that are either of the following:

- (a) Is designated as a priority school by the State Superintendent of Education.
- (b) Does not exclusively serve a special population of students and has received a D or an F on the most recent state report card.

Business Rules for Calculation to meet the requirements of ACT 2018-418 to determine priority schools:

- 1. Determine current/open schools and remove any school that exclusively serves a special population.
- 2. Determine the schools for school year 2022-2023 that have a D or an F on the fall 2023 state report card.
- 3. This list will be revised annually in accordance with the law.
