RE: Mathematics Intervention Resources Funding, Allocations, Selection, and Guidance Information

A list of approved Mathematics Intervention Resources was published in the [September 6, 2023](#), memorandum. This memorandum provides funding, allocations, selection, and guidance information for approved intervention resources.

Funds for Mathematics Intervention Resources will be allocated to local education agencies (LEAs) on a \$6 per-pupil basis for students in K-5. The per-pupil allocation was based on the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Average Daily Membership (ADM). The fund source is 1235.

The allocations for startup (Attachment A) and FY 2024 (Attachment B) are attached. Startup funding is provided to assist LEAs in securing required intervention resources for this initial year of implementation, 2023-2024. Allocations are scheduled to be released in two installments, with payments in January and July.

The LEAs will contract with the approved Mathematics Intervention Resource program of their choice. All LEAs are required to register their selection of Math Intervention Resources and other Alabama State Department of Education-funded resources by completing [this form](#) by February 1, 2024.
