RE: Revisions to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024 Fractional Reasoning Screener Administration Schedule and Funding Information

This memorandum revises the administration schedule and funding information for the Fractional Reasoning Screener for FY 2024 previously announced in the [September 7, 2023](#), memorandum.

Proposals submitted for the Fractional Reasoning Screeners through [RFP 2023-08](#) and [RFI 2023](#) were evaluated following the rules governing Alabama State Department of Education procurement for their alignment with the administration, data use, reporting, and monitoring requirements set forth in the *Alabama Numeracy Act*. No Fractional Reasoning Screeners were submitted for review. As a result, Fractional Reasoning Screeners will not be funded, nor administered for School Year (SY) 2023-2024.

The remainder of the administration schedule announced in the [September 7, 2023](#), memorandum will remain in effect for SY 2023-2024. The revised attachments reflect the updated allocations for startup (Attachment A) and FY 2024 (Attachment B). The allocations are scheduled to be released in two installments, with payments in January and July.
