REVIEW OF THE DRAFT 2022 ALABAMA COURSE OF STUDY: CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION - CALL FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Montgomery, Ala. - In a constant effort to improve outcomes for students, the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) is asking for public feedback specifically related to the *Draft 2022 Alabama Course of Study: Career and Technical Education*.

This review is an opportunity to offer feedback related to each standard for each course. This draft contains the proposed Grades 6-12 Career and Technical Education content for Cosmetology, Education and Training, and Hospitality and Tourism. Standards in these documents specify what students in Alabama should know and be able to do.

In order to receive public input, the survey and a copy of the draft are being made available on the ALSDE website and will be posted from **Tuesday**, **August 9**, **2022**, **through 5:00 p.m. Friday**, **September 9**, **2022**.
