## REVIEW OF THE DRAFT 2022 LIBRARY MEDIA MODEL FOR ALABAMA SCHOOLS CALL FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

**Montgomery, Ala.** - In a constant effort to improve outcomes for students, the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) is asking for public feedback specifically related to the *Draft 2022 Library Media Model for Alabama Schools*.

This review is an opportunity to offer feedback related to guidelines for Alabama school libraries. Guidelines in this document outline best practices for teaching and learning in school libraries as well as the administration and management of libraries.
