RE: Alabama Remote Learning Opportunities

To answer several wide-spread questions, I am providing the following preliminary information about the state's remote learning opportunities. A contract for statewide virtual content is being finalized. SchoolsPLP has been chosen to provide course content for all Grades K-12. This content is presently being loaded into the state instance of PowerSchool's Schoology, our state Learning Management System (LMS) [a list of the courses being provided by SchoolsPLP is attached to this memorandum, as well as the 7-12 Alabama Connecting Classrooms, Educators, and Students Statewide (ACCESS) franchise content and the regular ACCESS program's course offerings]. Once this task is accomplished and the Schoology training for two educators from each local education agency (LEA) scheduled for July 6-10 has been completed, it will be time for LEAs to begin pulling the courses that they wish to use into their instance of Schoology. The goal is to have all courses loaded in the state instance and available to you by July 15.

Directions for your staff to pull these courses into your instance of Schoology are being developed and will be shared during the CLAS Webinar on July 7, 2020. This course content will also be available if you wish to place it into other Learning Platforms, such as Canvas, Moodle, etc. It will be your responsibility to move any content from the statewide instance of Schoology to these other LMSs.

Professional Development (PD) will be key to having a successful virtual component in your systems. A thorough understanding of how to work within the LMS is the first step. This Schoology PD should be provided to all your teachers by those trained next week. Additional assistance will be available from SchoolsPLP about its content, but the primary focus should be a working knowledge of Schoology.
