Prior to utilizing the purchasing cooperative, the *Code of Alabama 1975*, Section 16-13B-2 requires the school board to verify that the goods or services are not at the time available on the state purchasing program, or that they are available at a price equal to or less than that on the state purchasing program. Additionally required is the verification that the purchase is made through a participating Alabama vendor holding an Alabama business license if such as vendor exists.
