GENERAL INFORMATION

Individuals who have completed a bachelor's level National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) – accredited program in child development for birth through age 4 may seek an Early Childhood Development Certificate for birth through age 4. Although this certificate is not a Professional Educator Certificate, holders may be employed in Alabama schools and may pursue the Class B Birth Through Age 4 Professional Educator Certificate.

APPLICATION PACKET**APPLICATION FORMS AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS ARE NOT ACCEPTED BY FAX OR E-MAIL.**

An application packet for Alabama certification must include the items listed below:

Supplement CIT with supporting documentation verifying United States citizenship or lawful presence in the United States.

Application Form ECD.

A \$30.00 **nonrefundable** application fee. Each additional certificate for which an applicant is determined to be eligible will require a \$30.00 nonrefundable fee for issuance. **Neither personal checks nor cash will be accepted.**

- The fee must be paid by cashier's check **or** money order made payable to the Alabama State Department of Education or through the Alabama State Department of Education Educator Certification Online Payment System, with a major credit card, at www.alabamainteractive.org/education (a \$4.00 transaction fee will be applied).
- The cashier's check, money order, or copy of the receipt verifying the confirmation number for the online payment must accompany the application packet.

Background clearance based on a fingerprint review.

- Applicants may verify whether their ASBI and FBI criminal history background checks have been completed and whether they are suitable and fit to teach under state law at <https://tcert.alsde.edu/Portal>.
- Applicants for initial certification, additional certification, and certificate renewal **who have not been cleared** by both the Alabama State Bureau of Investigation (ASBI) and Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) through the Educator Certification Section of the ALSDE are required to be fingerprinted for a criminal history background check through the ASBI and FBI.
- Applicants **living in** Alabama are to complete the background clearance process at a designated fingerprint site. Instructions are available through Gemalto Cogent by calling (866) 989-9316.
- Applicants **living outside** of Alabama who are not able to report to a designated fingerprint site in Alabama are to:
 - Visit the Gemalto Cogent Web site to register online AND _____
 - Send an email to tcertforms@alsde.edu to request two fingerprint cards (you must include full name and mailing address).
 - Once the fingerprint cards are received, the applicant must contact a local law enforcement agency outside of Alabama to be fingerprinted on the cards received from the Educator Certification Section. After being fingerprinted, the applicant must send one completed fingerprint card and applicable fee made payable to Gemalto Cogent to the following address: Gemalto Cogent / ALSDE Cards Scan / 639 North Rosemead Boulevard / Pasadena, CA 91107.
 - The applicant should keep the second completed fingerprint card in case a reprint notice is received from Gemalto Cogent.

An official transcript of a bachelor's degree with a minimum overall grade point average (GPA)* of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale, from a senior institution that was regionally accredited at the time the degree was earned.

*The overall GPA must be the GPA that was used as the basis for granting the degree and posted on the official transcript of the degree-granting institution.

Official transcripts of all degrees and credits earned must be submitted to the Educator Certification Section in a sealed envelope from the institution(s). The applicant's current full name and Social Security number must accompany the transcript(s). Official transcripts may also be submitted securely to the Educator Certification Section through electronic transmission by only the following transcript services:

- Credentials Solutions' TranscriptNetwork™, **OR**
- eSCRIP-SAFE, **OR**
- National Student Clearinghouse. (**Note:** There are two methods that National Student Clearinghouse uses to submit transcripts electronically (1) Electronic Transcript Exchange and (2) Electronic PDF. Electronic PDF transcripts will **not** be accepted by this Section.)

Supplement CD1 should be forwarded by the applicant to the dean or the head of the unit that houses the NAEYC-accredited program for completion. The completed Supplement CD1 is to be forwarded by the institution to the applicant in a sealed envelope and should not be opened prior to submission to the Educator Certification Section.
