For students scoring below 455:

- Notify parents using the ACAP Individual Student Report (ISR)
- Develop or revise and implement Student Reading Improvement Plan (SRIP) in collaboration with parents/caregivers
- Provide parents/caregivers with a Read at Home Plan
- Invite student to Summer Reading Camp
- Provide Tier 3 intensive
 intervention (in addition to Tier 1
 and Tier 2) until the student no
 longer has a deficiency in reading
- Provide additional tutorial support (before and/or after school) during student's 3rd grade year
- Begin a collection of evidence/work samples for review
- Provide monthly reports of student progress to parents/caregivers

For students scoring below 435:

- Notify parents using the ACAP Individual Student Report (ISR)
- Discuss the paths to promotion with parents/caregivers
- Review or develop and implement the Student Reading Improvement Plan (SRIP) in collaboration with parents/caregivers
- Invite student to Summer Reading Camp
- Administer the ACAP
 Supplemental Reading Test during summer testing
- Collect evidence for the student's Literacy Act Portfolio
- Provide monthly reports of student progress to parents/caregivers
- Determine student's path to promotion or retention based on the ACAP Supplemental Reading score (Teacher, Principal, and Superintendent)
