## **Calculating Four-Year Cohort Graduation Rate**

The **four-year cohort** is based on the number of students who enter Grade 9 for the first time.

Each cohort is identified by the **base year** and the **graduation year**.

- The base year is the actual year a student is a first-time ninth grader.
- The graduation year is the year a student is expected to graduate within the four-year cohort.

#### The 2023 Four-Year Cohort Graduation Rate is 90.04%
