RE: Title IX Rule Changes

On April 19, 2024, states were notified that the US Department of Education had reinterpreted Title IX, essentially changing the application of the law. Many state attorneys general, including Alabama Attorney General Steve Marshall, have stated their concerns about this new interpretation, including possible Constitutionality issues.

Based on the recommendation from Attorney General Marshall, all local education agencies (LEAs) in the state of Alabama are advised **not** to implement the new Title IX rules at this time due to the pending litigation. Further, LEAs should note that, as drafted, the federal regulations have an August 1, 2024, effective date. Additional guidance will be issued once the courts have weighed in on the validity of these regulations.

In the meantime, LEAs in Alabama are reminded that this prohibition relates to the new rule change expanding the definition of "sex" only, and that LEAs should still comply with existing Title IX requirements, including that no one, on the basis of sex, "be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination" in education programs and activities. 20 U.S.C. §1681(a).
