The table on page 8 of the RFP indicates that PreACT Secure and the ACT with Writing are both in scope for this RFP and are required statewide assessments. However, because the RFP prohibits vendors from proposing commercially off-the-shelf assessments, please confirm that the new high school assessments which ALSDE is seeking to develop through this solicitation are in addition to PreACT Secure and the ACT, and will not replace those assessments and Alabama will continue to administer PreACT Secure and the ACT under a separate contract.	The chart you are referring to includes all assessments that are presently required.
Please clarify the response provided in the question above. Does this mean that since the ACT and PreACT Secure are in scope for this RFP, that a proposal including these products will be accepted, even though they are off-the-shelf assessments? While this may contradict the language on page 6 that states "Commercial off-the-shelf assessments or products will not meet the needs of this proposal" it may be supported by the language on page 110 that states "ALSDE is not seeing to use vendor owned items unless there is compelling psychometric rationale."
