



# Four-Year Graduation Rate



### Calculating Four-Year Cohort Graduation Rate

The four-year cohort is based on the number of students who enter Grade 9 for the first time.

Each cohort is identified by the Base Year and the Graduation Year.

- The Base Year is the actual year a student is a first-time ninth grader.
- The Grad Year is the year a student is expected to graduate within the four-year cohort.
