### Support School Information and Lists

#### Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) Schools

Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) Schools are identified every three (3) years. CSI schools will be identified in the fall of 2025. Any CSI school identified that fails to exit CSI status will be named a CSI-R school.

#### Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) Schools

Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) Schools are identified annually. Schools that are already identified as CSI or ATSI are not eligible for TSI status.

#### Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) Schools

Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) Schools are identified every three (3) years. ATSI schools will be identified in the fall of 2025. Any ATSI school identified that fails to exit ATSI status will be named a CSI school.

#### Exit Criteria

A school identified for CSI support may exit such status after three years if the school performs above the bottom 5% of schools receiving Title I, Part A funds and shows improvement as compared to when the school was originally identified. Schools previously identified as CSI based on graduation rate must have a graduation rate at or above 67% to exit CSI status.

A school identified for Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) support may exit such status after three years if the school no longer meets the eligibility criteria for targeted support and demonstrates improved performance as compared to performance at the time of identification for the student subgroup for which the school is identified.
