Section I Assessment Table Utilization

Individuals must meet the current test and score requirements in effect on the date the application for Alabama certification is received in the Educator Certification Section of the ALSDE.

Additional guidelines pertaining to the following Alternative Certification Approaches:

- Business and Industry to Educational Administrator (BIEA) Approach
- Conditional Certificate in a Teaching Field (CCTF) Approach
- Provisional Certificate in a Teaching Field (PCTF) Approach
- Provisional Certification in Library Media or School Counseling (PCLS) Approach
- Temporary Special Education Certificate (TSCE)
- 1. Effective for applications received in the Educator Certification Section of the ALSDE September 1, 2025, and thereafter:
 - a. The Praxis Subject Assessment (content knowledge) must be the test under the Current Test columns on the chart. No previous tests will be accepted.
 - b. The Praxis Subject Assessment (content knowledge) must be appropriate to the content area for which the individual began the alternative approach.
 - c. The Praxis Subject Assessment (content knowledge) and score required at the time of receipt of the application for the first alternative certificate will be acceptable for issuance of a professional certificate, as long as the individual completes the approach in the allotted time frame.
- 2. Effective for applications received in the Educator Certification Section of the ALSDE prior to September 1, 2025:
 - a. The Praxis Subject Assessment (content knowledge) and score required at the time of receipt of the application for the first alternative certificate will be acceptable for issuance of a professional certificate if the individual completes the approach in the allotted time frame.
 - b. The Praxis Subject Assessment (content knowledge) must be appropriate to the content area for which the individual began the alternative approach.
- 3. Individuals who do not meet the minimum overall undergraduate GPA requirement for the first **PCTF** or **CCTF** but have at least a 2.0 overall undergraduate GPA, must meet the Praxis Subject Assessments (content knowledge) and scores required on the Increased Praxis Score Requirements document which may be found at Increased Praxis Score Option.

Section II

Content Knowledge Assessments by Certification Area

The Praxis Subject Assessment (content knowledge) is required for individuals applying for initial certification in a teaching field <u>or</u> to change grade levels in the same teaching field for which a certificate is held.

The Praxis Subject Assessment (content knowledge) is required for individuals applying for initial certification in an area of instructional support <u>or</u> to change grade levels in the same area of instructional support for which a certificate is held.

The Praxis Subject Assessment (content knowledge) is applicable for individuals applying through the following approaches:

- Additional Teaching Field Approach / Certification Based on Test (CBT)
- Business and Industry to Educational Administrator (BIEA)
- Certificate Reciprocity (see application to determine if testing will be required)
- Computer Science Additional Teaching Field Approach (CST)
- Conditional Certificate in a Teaching Field (CCTF)
- Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP)
- Early Childhood Development
- Foreign Credentials
- Interim Employment Certificate (IEC) (see certification officer at Alabama college or university)
- Nationally Certified School Psychologist
- Provisional Certificate in a Teaching Field (PCTF)
- Provisional Certificate in Library Media or School Counseling (PCLS)
- Temporary Special Education Certificate (TSEC)

The approaches listed above may also require tests other than a Praxis Subject Assessment (content knowledge).

Section VI Pedagogical Assessments

Pedagogical Assessments are required for individuals applying based on the following approaches:

- Career and Technical Certificate to a Professional Educator Certificate
- Conditional Certificate in a Teaching Field (CCTF)
- Early Childhood Development
- Foreign Credentials
- Provisional Certificate in a Teaching Field (PCTF)

Career and Technical Certificate to a Professional Educator Certificate - The Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) is the required pedagogical assessment for issuance of the Professional Educator Certificate.

Conditional Certificate in a Teaching Field (CCTF):

- For individuals who complete all CCTF requirements in one or two years, the edTPA is the required pedagogical assessment for issuance of the Professional Educator Certificate following the CCTF Approach.
- For individuals who complete all CCTF requirements in three years, **either** the edTPA **or** PLT may be used to meet the pedagogical assessment requirement for issuance of the Professional Educator Certificate following the CCTF Approach.
- For teaching fields where an edTPA handbook has not been developed, the PLT is the required pedagogical assessment for issuance of the Professional Educator Certificate following the CCTF Approach.

Early Childhood Development Certificate – The Educative Teacher Performance Assessment (edTPA) is the required pedagogical assessment for issuance of the Professional Educator Certificate.

Foreign Credentials - The PLT is the required pedagogical assessment for issuance of the Professional Educator Certificate.

Provisional Certificate in a Teaching Field (PCTF):

- For individuals who complete all PCTF requirements in one or two years, the edTPA is the required pedagogical assessment for issuance of the Professional Educator Certificate following the PCTF Approach.
- For individuals who complete all PCTF requirements in three years, **either** the edTPA **or** PLT may be used to meet the pedagogical assessment requirement for issuance of the Professional Educator Certificate following the PCTF Approach.
- For teaching fields where an edTPA handbook has not been developed, the PLT is the required pedagogical assessment for issuance of the Professional Educator Certificate following the PCTF Approach.

Neither edTPA nor PLT will be required if the individual holds a valid Alabama professional educator certificate in a teaching field.
