- Reasons for Attrition
- Major Initiatives and/or Points of Pride at EPPs
- Continuous Improvement Processes at EPPs

Surveys



Surveys Include

Who?

- First-year and second-year teachers who completed a Class B or Alternative Class A program at an Alabama institution.
- Employers of those first-year and second-year teachers.

What?

- Summary of survey categories and percentages from first-year and second-year teacher responses.
- Summary of survey categories and percentages from employer responses.

Assessments



Assessments Includes

Praxis, Foundations of Reading, and edTPA data; by pass rate percentages:

- Filterable by EPP
- Easily comparable to state-level data

Teacher Shortage



Teacher Shortage Includes

A pie chart of shortages by teaching field or area of instructional support, as reported by the LEA.

Future work in this area will focus on aligning shortage areas with surrounding EPPs.


