RE: Act 2025-268: Third Allocation Supplemental Funding
Alabama School Breakfast Grant

Act 2025-268, authorizes supplemental appropriations for Alabama’s Fiscal Year 2025, ending September 30, 2025. As part of this legislation, funds have been designated to support schools participating in the School Breakfast Program that provide meals at no cost to all students through the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) or Universal Breakfast.

This memorandum serves as notification that your School Food Authority (SFA) has been selected to receive funding through the third allocation, distributed as the Alabama School Breakfast Grant. This allocation targets eligible schools that did not receive funding through the first or second allocations.

Purpose of the Funding

- Offset the financial burden on schools serving breakfast to all students, regardless of income eligibility.
- Ensure students across Alabama have access to nutritious morning meals at no cost.
- Promote student well-being through improved nutritional support.

Allocation and Use of Funds

- Funds should be applied to cover the cost of meals that would otherwise be paid for by students not eligible for free or reduced meals; or
- Funds should be applied to cover the cost of equipment and supplies for alternate breakfast models; or
- Funds should be used to serve Alabama grown Farm to School foods in schools.

Promoting Participation

Schools receiving this funding are encouraged to promote their breakfast programs through the state’s **“Strong Start and Strong Finish with Alabama’s School Breakfast”** campaign. Social media artwork and promotional materials are available at breakforaplate.com.

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Disbursement of Funds

Funds will be automatically disbursed with this memo and should be recorded using revenue code 2901 and fund source code 5101. The first allocation was disbursed on August 11, 2025, to all schools that participated in the CEP and Universal Breakfast in school year 2025. The second allocation included schools new to the CEP and Universal Breakfast in school year 2026. This third allocation is distributed in the form of a grant and is based on the approved application submitted by the SFA. SFAs are responsible for maintaining appropriate documentation to support the use of funds.
